when we will be receiving the State money. He stated that Absolut has almost finished with Appalachian Road and Hunter Hill Road. Dan stated that he met with LUPC and the town does need to extend Stratton Brook Road. It will entail graveling etc. Absolut will be giving Dan an estimate and this will go into the budget for next year.
